Definition

"Passion is the God-given desire that compels us to make a difference in a particular area of ministry or life where God is glorified and people are edified."

(Bruce Bugbee, What You Do Best, p. 35)

Description

Three general categories have been suggested which tend to overlap.

- a) people-passions: groups such as children, youth, elderly, single-parent families, immigrants, bereaved, poor, prisoners etc.
- b) function-passions: reaching the lost, discipling, teaching, counseling, mentoring, leadership training, church planting, missions etc.
- c) cause-passions: unity in the Body of Christ, revival, financial stewardship, racial reconciliation, protecting the unborn, world hunger, environment, etc.
