## OUR 2022-23 SPONSORSHIP GOALS

As we restart CVSOM this school year, it is still our goal to keep the tuition as affordable as possible. However, the tuition alone does not cover 100% of the school's expenses.

Some students will pay the full tuition up front, but many others will be paying as they go. This makes the tuition affordable but doesn't allow us the operating expenses that are needed for each trimester.

In order to facilitate the school properly while maintaining affordability, we are asking the Lord to provide 1 year's operational budget of \$50,000.

Being 1 year cash positive will ensure CVSOM can perpetually be generous by offering low tuition, and scholarships for those who would otherwise not be able to attend. Having these funds in advance will play a critical role in growing the school's curriculum and programs, promoting the school in churches throughout the Central Valley, and integrating technology to effectively engage and inspire the next generation of students.

The need for passionate, educated, Christian, leaders in our valley is great. CVSOM has a proven history of producing those leaders.

As a ministry to the Church, CVSOM needs partners in the Church, to continue the mission of producing quality leaders for the Church. This is a Kingdom investment that we have seen produce substantial kingdom returns.
